

Stake Responsibilities for Regional Midsingles Dances

Midsingles dances are held the 4th Friday of each month from 9pm - midnight
Building is already reserved for 2011 from 8 pm – past midnight every 4th Friday
(Little Valley Stake Center @ 1762 S. River Rd)

The DJ will be scheduled and paid by the Regional Midsingles Committee

- Set up for dances (table and chairs, cups and pitchers of water, etc) at 8 pm (building will be opened for you)
- Purchase and prepare food (optional)
- Budget for each dance (food, decorations) is a maximum of \$50. Reimbursement forms can be downloaded and printed from the website (www.ldssgmidsingles.com) and must be submitted—with original receipts—to a member of the regional steering committee
- **Any additional information about your dance (i.e. theme, potluck ideas, etc) should be submitted to Lyman Stirling, website administrator, at sgmidsingles@gmail.com or 435-705-0637**
- **Also, please give info to Rachel Gubler (435-632-8506) to put on Facebook and send out texts**
- Begin and end dances with a prayer
- Provide 2-4 volunteers (at least 2 priesthood holders) to be present from 8:45 pm – 12:30 am (approx) to chaperone, work in the kitchen (if needed), assure dance regulations (below) are maintained, etc.
- Clean up after dances, turn off building lights, and lock doors

Dance Regulations (from the Church Handbook):

- The beat of the music should not overshadow the melody
- The volume should be low enough to allow 2 people who are standing side by side to hear each other and carry on a normal conversation
- Lights should be bright enough for people to see across the room
- Strobe lights and psychedelic lighting that pulsate with the beat are *not acceptable*
- Lights on the floor, in corners of the room, or spotlighting wall and ceiling decorations are *okay*
